## STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

### **Ms June Wilson**

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

*“Ms June Wilson JP, a magistrate assigned to the Central London local justice area, has been subject to a disciplinary investigation regarding her failure to report her own arrest and separately the arrest, conviction and prison sentence of a close family member. The Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice found that Ms Wilson had breached the Declaration and Undertaking she signed upon appointment, which requires that such matters are reported to the justices’ clerk, and that her behaviour in this matter amounted to serious misconduct. They have removed Ms Wilson from the magistracy with immediate effect.”*
