STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice have made a finding of misconduct against Mrs Jayne Harding, a magistrate assigned to the South West London area, following her failure to engage with her bench chair to discuss her conduct. The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb considered that Mrs Harding’s behaviour fell below the standards expected of a magistrate and have issued her with formal advice.”
