STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

Mr Paul Romoff JP

A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Mr Paul Romoff JP, a magistrate appointed to the Greater Manchester local justice area, has been subject to a conduct investigation after he did not take reasonable steps to ensure that he was fit enough to sit. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice found that Mr Romoff’s actions amounted to misconduct and have issued him with a formal warning. No trial outcomes were affected by his actions.”
