STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

Mr Graham Angell JP

A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have removed Mr Graham Angell JP, of the Black Country Local Justice Area, from the magistracy. Mr Angell failed to meet the minimum sitting requirements of his appointment without reasonable excuse. Mr Angell was also subject to professional conduct proceedings as a headmaster which resulted in him being prohibited from practising his profession indefinitely. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice found that Mr Angell’s actions were incompatible with holding judicial office.”
