A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have issued Mr Aftab Haque JP with formal advice after he pleaded guilty to a speeding offence which resulted in six points and a £600 fine. Mr Haque’s conduct fell below the high standard expected of a judicial office holder.”
