“The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice have issued Atul Gandecha JP with formal advice for misconduct after an investigation determined that he had posted a picture of himself on social media along with a caption which could have created the impression that he did not take his role as a magistrate seriously.”
