STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

Tribunal Judge Nicholas Easterman

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and the Senior President of Tribunals have made a finding of misconduct against Judge Nicholas Easterman, a tribunal judge of the First-tier Immigration and Asylum Chamber. The Judge made comments in a case, which were injudicious and could be perceived as biased. The Lord Chancellor and the Senior President of Tribunals considered that his behaviour fell below the standards expected of a judge and have issued him with formal advice”.
