## STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

*“The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema Grubb, on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice, have issued Roger Warrington JP with a warning for his involvement in an inappropriate conversation on social media. The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema Grubb concluded that by being a party to the conversation Mr Warrington had not upheld the high standards of behaviour expected of a judicial office holder.”*
