## STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

**Mr Adam Rubens JP**

A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

*“Adam Rubens JP, a magistrate from the North West London Bench, has been issued with a reprimand after a disciplinary investigation found that he had made a number of comments to fellow magistrates about participants in the case considered to be inappropriate. The Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice concluded that Mr Rubens’ behaviour fell below the high standards expected of a judicial office holder and amounted to misconduct.”*
