“The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice, have issued Michael Lesser JP, with a warning following a speeding offence which took him to nine points on his driving licence and for a failure to promptly report this. They concluded that Mr Lesser’s conduct fell below the high standards expected of a judicial office holder and amounted to misconduct.”
