“The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice have issued Joanna Lindfield JP, a magistrate on the North Wales Bench, with formal advice. Ms Lindfield was subject to a complaint after she made a negative comment in court regarding a firm of solicitors which risked calling into question her impartiality.”
