STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Mr Glenn Toney JP, from the Black Country Local Justice Area, has been issued with formal advice for using his status as a magistrate in a letter sent to influence a decision of a company to benefit his partner, an ex-employee. The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb DBE on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice concluded that Mr Toney had misused his judicial status, which falls below the standards expected of a judicial office holder.”
