## STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

**Mr Stanley Mallows JP**

A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb DBE have issued Stanley Mallows JP, a magistrate from the Lincolnshire Bench, with a formal warning after he referred to his judicial status in a way that was intended to be threatening - *“Just wait until you are in front of me”* - during a telephone conversation with a former friend. While finding that Mr Mallows made the remark in the heat of the moment, the Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb DBE concluded that he had misused his judicial status.”
