## STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

**Mr Simon Baxter JP**

A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have issued Simon Baxter JP, a magistrate assigned to the Humber Bench, with a formal warning after he committed a speeding offence which took the total number of penalty points on his driver’s licence to 12. Mr Baxter also failed to report these matters promptly to his bench chairman.”
