## STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

### Recorder Julian Malins QC

A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said

“The conduct of Recorder Malins QC has been investigated following a complaint that he made an inappropriate personal comment about a person who appeared before him in court. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have issued Recorder Malins QC with a formal warning. In reaching this decision they took into consideration that the recorder failed to acknowledge the inappropriateness of his conduct.”
