STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

David Jepson JP

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“David Jepson JP, of the Nottinghamshire Local Justice Area, has been removed from the magistracy after his company, of which he was the sole director, became insolvent and left an unpaid County Court judgment and HMRC demand. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice decided that Mr Jepson’s continuance in office would bring the magistracy into disrepute.”
