STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Mr Barry Cave JP, a supplemental magistrate from the Liverpool Knowsley Bench, has been issued with a formal warning after an investigation established that he had behaved irresponsibly in his former role with the Independent Monitoring Board, at HMP Forest Bank. The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb DBE on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice concluded that Mr Cave’s actions amounted to misconduct and have issued him with a formal warning”.
