“The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb DBE, on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice, have issued David Senior JP, a magistrate assigned to the Dorset Bench, with a formal advice for an ageist comment he made to a colleague and remarks he made in an email to his bench chairman. In reaching their decision, they took into consideration that Mr Senior had expressed regret for his actions.”
