STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

Dr Joseph Ukemenam

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and the Senior President of Tribunals, acting on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice, have issued Dr Joseph Ukemenam, a non-legal member of the Employment Tribunal, with a formal warning. Dr Ukemenam accumulated twelve points on his driving licence for driving without valid insurance and was disqualified from driving for six months. He also breached his obligations to promptly report these matters and to report his involvement as a claimant in an Employment Tribunal claim. In reaching their decision, the Lord Chancellor and the Senior President of Tribunals took into consideration that Dr Ukemenam had accepted responsibility and apologised.”
