STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

Mrs Gina Stevenson JP

A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice have removed Gina Stevenson, a magistrate assigned to the Nottingham Bench, from office for failing to disclose, when she was a candidate for the magistracy, that one of her sons had recently been convicted of a criminal offence. This was in breach of clear guidance given to all candidates. Following her appointment, Mrs Stevenson continued not to comply with her obligation to report relevant matters to the bench. She did not respond when invited to explain her conduct.”
