STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

Mr Norman Marshall JP

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Mr Norman Marshall JP, a magistrate from the South West London Bench, has received a formal warning after he behaved in a bullying manner towards a fellow magistrate during a private meeting unrelated to any case in court, covertly recorded part of that meeting and sent an email to a number of people criticising the same magistrate. The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb DBE, on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice, concluded that Mr Marshall’s behaviour fell below the high standards expected of a judicial office holder and amounted to misconduct.”
