STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

Dr Robyn Scott

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Dr Robyn Scott, a non-legal member of the Social Security and Child Support Jurisdiction of the Social Entitlement Chamber of the First-tier Tribunal, has been issued with a reprimand for making an inappropriate remark during a post-hearing discussion with colleagues. In reaching their decision, the Lord Chief Justice and the Lord Chancellor took into consideration that Dr Scott had accepted responsibility for her actions, apologised and gave assurances as to her future conduct.”
