A spokesperson from the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb DBE, on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice, have issued Dr Nigel Molden JP, a magistrate on the Supplemental List, with a formal warning following a careless driving conviction and the accrual of six penalty points on his driving licence. In considering this matter, the Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice noted his continuing denial of any wrong doing and also took into account Dr Molden’s timely disclosure to his Bench Chair, and his otherwise clean driving and disciplinary records.”
