## STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

**Amanda Lowy JP**

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema Grubb DBE, on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice, have issued Mrs Amanda Lowy JP, of the West Sussex Bench, with formal advice for accumulating nine points for road traffic offences within an eighteen-month period. In reaching their decision they considered that Mrs Lowy was dealing with difficult personal circumstances at the time of the offences and had expressed a considerable degree of remorse for her actions.”
