STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

His Honour Judge Glenn

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

““The Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice have issued His Honour Judge Paul Glenn with formal advice after he was found to have misused his judicial status after he wrote a letter to a magistrate which could have been construed as an attempt to influence a sentencing decision. In reaching their decision, the Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice took into consideration that His Honour Judge Glenn took responsibility for his actions and has a long record of good conduct as a judge.”
