A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“The Lord Chancellor and Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb DBE, on behalf of the Lord Chief Justice, have issued Mohammed Kabir JP, of the Bedfordshire Bench with a formal warning for failing to meet the sittings requirements of his role and failing to undertake his appraisal. In reaching their decision, they accepted Mr Kabir’s mitigation and noted that he had taken steps to ensure he would be able to meet sitting requirements henceforth.”
