Hi

I am also a victim of these complex rules. UKVI caseworkers do not consider me owner of my limited company.

In order to run a limited company in UK, there must be one director and one sole shareholder.

As a sole shareholder you can claim net profit of your company and claim previous earnings points instead UKVI just consider you a company director which is not entitled to claim company profit under HMRC rules.

They do this intentionally and confuse judges in the courts under these complex and wrong rules.

UKVI grant visa under the same rules in initial application and take different approach and view in extension application under the same rules while you submit exact same documents in both applications.

I hope your effort in this project will help lots of people to get out of this spider web(UKVI rules)..
