Comment text:

I live in Wells House Road, [REDACTED] which is currently in East Acton and I represent the Wells House Road residents association. We are very concerned that Ealing Council has not consulted with residents on the boundary changes. We hear by rumour that our councillors are trying to change the boundaries to form an area called NORTH ACTON. Although we approve of this in theory, Wells House Road needs to be retained in the same ward as other communities impacted by the 10 years of HS2 development and within the OPDC (Old Oak Park Royal Development Corporation) boundaries. These other communities that we work together with as a single unit are: TITRA (railway cottages close to Willesden Junction), Wesley Estate, Midland Terrace and Shaftesbury Gardens. Wells House Road is already isolated and will stand totally alone if it remains in East Acton while the other communities move to North Acton. We wish to stay together to prevent this isolation as there are no other communities in East Acton with similar impacts. Cutting us off from our partner communities would mean that we have NO RESOURCES to defend ourselves against the impacts of these MEGA DEVELOPMENTS. PLEASE PLEASE PLEASE allow us to remain united. If anything, it would make better sense for our communities to move into Hammersmith and Fulham. The impacts around the HS2 station at Old Oak Common and most of the OPDC development will happen in LBHF and it's Ealing residents who will be impacted. Therefore no Section 106 money comes our way to mitigate against the impacts. In addition, Ealing Council has NO INTEREST in communities around the OPDC area and totally neglects us. We would be delighted to divorce our council but if you won't permit this, then you need to keep us together. EALING HAS NOT CONSULTED WITH OLD OAK PARK ROYAL RESIDENTS on boundary changes. This is another example of their neglect and disrespect. THERE NEEDS TO BE A PROPER CONSULTATION WITH A DOOR DROP OF PROPOSALS BEFORE THIS GOES AHEAD. Is this really legal???
