

# LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

## The Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Tidbury Green) Order 2020

Made Second day of March ~~February~~ 2020

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council ("the Council"), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 14<sup>th</sup> January 2020.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient.

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

### Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Tidbury Green) Order 2020.

(2) Subject to paragraphs (3) and (4) below, this Order comes into force on 1st April 2020.

(3) Article 4 shall come into force on 7<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

(4) For the purposes of:

(a) this article, and

(b) proceedings preliminary or relating to the elections of parish councillors for the parish of Tidbury Green, to be held on 7<sup>th</sup> May 2020,

this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

### Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"borough" means the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull;

"existing" means existing on the date this Order is made;

"ordinary day of election of councillors" has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

**Effect of Order**

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

**Increase in Number of Parish Councillors for the Parish of Tidbury Green**

4. The number of councillors to represent the existing parish of Tidbury Green shall be increased from five (5) to seven (7).

**Election to fill the additional seats on the Council**

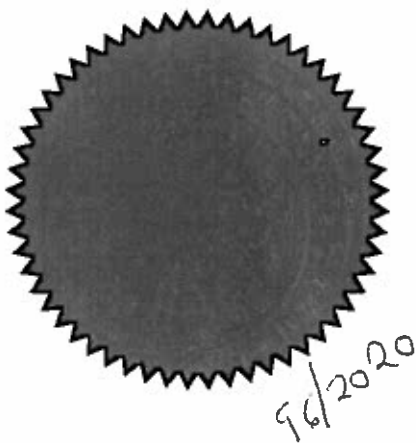
5. An election to fill the additional seats on the Council created by this Order shall be held on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

6. The Councillors elected on 7<sup>th</sup> May 2020 shall be elected to serve a 4 year term of office ending on the date of the ordinary election of parish councillors in 2024.

**Order date**

7. 1st April 2020 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council for the parish of Tidbury Green within the borough of Solihull.

The parish of Tidbury Green will be altered with effect from 1 April 2020. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after 7<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

Article 4 specifies the increased number of parish councillors for the parish of Tidbury Green.

Article 5 sets the date of 7<sup>th</sup> May 2020 for the election of Councillors to fill the two additional seats on the Council created by this Order.

Article 6 sets the term of office of the newly elected Councillors as 4 years so that the end coincides with that of the other members of the Parish Council.
