The current ward of Braunston & Belton has by reason of its location several unique issues and concerns. For example we are close to the Leicestershire border which Martinsthorpe is not, and any changes made "over the border" effect us and Braunston in Rutland more than anyone else. The A47 which is a major road is an important bus route, it is under a lot of pressure financially as a link to Leicester from Uppingham, Braunston in Rutland is also on an important link road from Oakham to Leicester, Martinsthorpe does not have these issues. Housing pressure is another concern that we have again because of our location, Corby, Leicester, major train stations, road links are all closer to us and that produces unique problems.
