NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

Currently there are:

- 59 councillors
- 31 wards
- 12 single-councillor wards,
10 two-councillor wards and
nine three-councillor wards

375 residents and organisations
helped shape our recommendations



We aim to make sure Central
Bedfordshire councillors represent a
similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- 9 wards more than
10% away from the average
number of electors per ward
- One ward is more than 30%
away from the average

From elections in 2023:

- 63 councillors
- 31 wards
- Nine single-councillor wards,
12 two-councillor wards and
10 three-councillor wards



2023 will move towards:

- One ward will be more than
10% away from the average
number of electors per ward
- Each councillor representing
an average of 3,604 electors
