

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Tendring District (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2018

Made 18th September 2018

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Tendring District Council ("the Council"), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a Community Governance Review and made recommendations dated 3 July 2018.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

1. Citation and commencement

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Tendring District (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2018.
- (2) It shall come into force on 1st April 2019.

2. Interpretation

In this Order—

"District" means the district of Tendring

"Map" means the map marked "Map referred to in the Tendring District (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2018" and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number;

"Registration Officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8(c) of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

3. Effect of Order

This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

4. Alteration of St Osyth Parish area and the St Osyth Parish Ward area

- (1) The area coloured red on the map shall cease to be part of the unparished area of West Clacton and Jaywick Sands and shall become part of the parish of St Osyth and St Osyth Parish Ward.

5. Electoral Register

The Registration Officer for the Tendring District shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

6. Order Date


1st April 2019 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

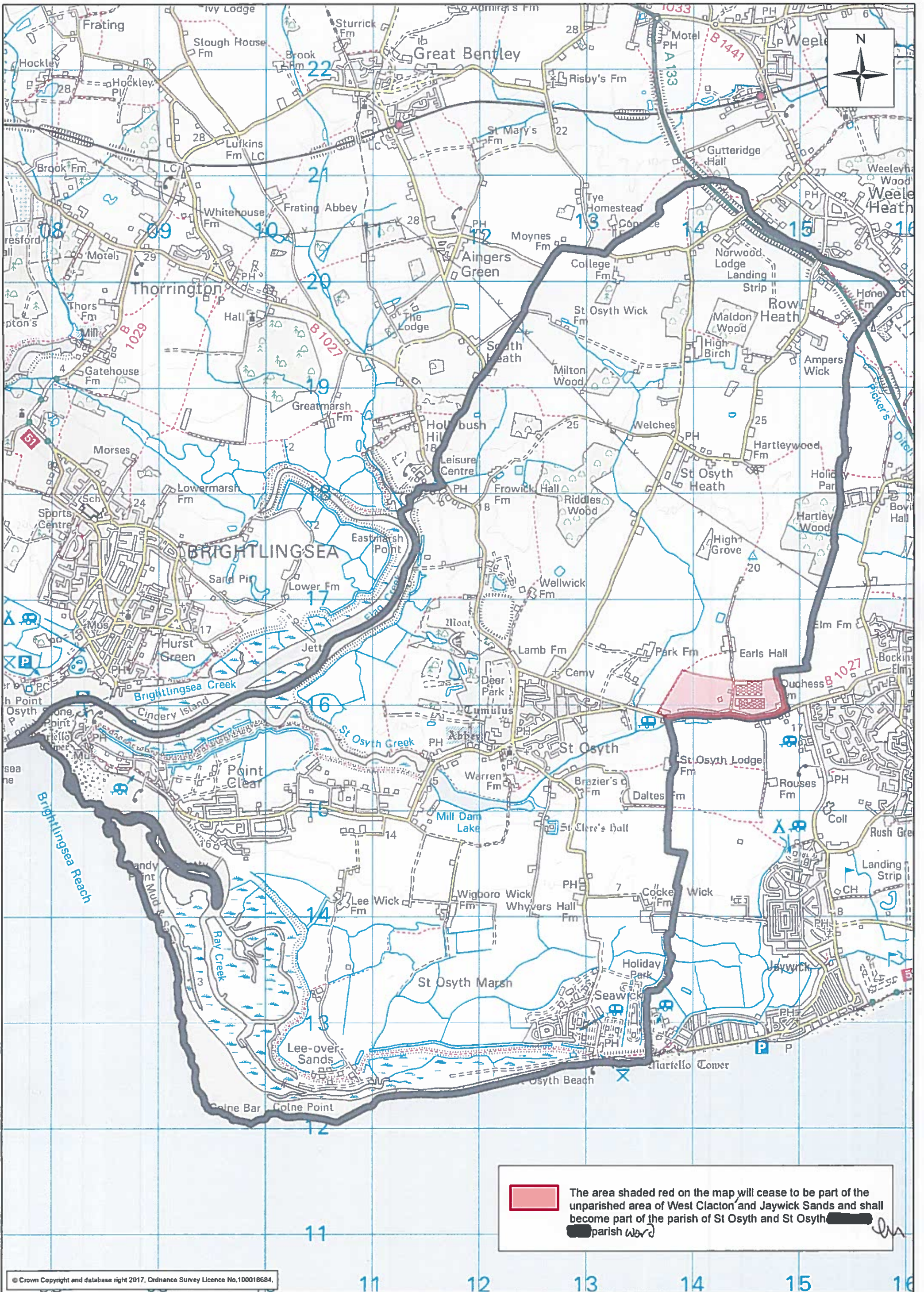
