Dear Paul,

The Council is not providing a detailed formal submission to the ward boundary consultation, however, Councillors that sit on the Electoral Review Panel meeting that has a remit to consider the Boundary Commission Review, discussed the Ward Boundary consultation and made the following comments which were agreed at the meeting would be submitted for consideration as part of the consultation process.

AGREED

1. That the Electoral Review Panel note the Boundary Commission's proposals and confirmed that the Council would not be providing a response to the consultation.
2. The following comments on behalf of the Electoral Review Panel for the attention of the Boundary Commission:
 - (a) The Panel was pleased to note that no 1 Member Wards were proposed.
 - (b) A view expressed by some Members of the Panel in support of 3 Member Wards where possible to appropriately reflect the electoral numbers in the wards.
 - (c) The Panel was pleased to note the major retail areas in Enfield Town had been included within one ward of Town, as set out in the report.
 - (d) A view expressed by some members of the Panel that the Whitewebbs Ward could be named the Forty Hall Ward to reflect the more densely populated area within the ward.
 - (e) The reassurance sought by some Members of the Panel that the Boundary Commission had taken the potential growth figures for the Meridian Water development into account in its proposals. The comment made that other potential major developments in the Borough would also need to be taken into consideration.
 - (f) That the Hoe Lane ward would be more appropriately named as Carterhatch Ward.
