ELECTORAL REVIEW OF ENFIELD: FURTHER DRAFT RECOMMENDATIONS

Following our consultation on the draft recommendations for Enfield, I am writing to inform you of the Commission's decision to hold a period of further limited consultation prior to publication of its final recommendations. This will involve our proposals for wards in the west of Enfield. The Commission believes it has received sufficient evidence in relation to the rest of the borough. Therefore, this period of further limited consultation focuses on these areas only.

During the consultation on our draft recommendations, which were published on 28 May 2019, we received 331 representations. We received significant opposition to our recommendations in the west of the borough and we are therefore publishing further draft recommendations for this area and are now inviting views on our revised warding pattern in these areas.

The proposed pattern is markedly different from that published as part of our original draft recommendations. Accordingly, the Commission has decided there should be a period of further limited consultation to seek the views of residents and locally interested parties regarding whether we should adopt the alternative pattern of wards.

This period of further limited consultation commences today, 29 October 2019, and closes on 25 November 2019. During this period, the Commission welcomes comments and supporting evidence on its revised recommendations for the western area of Enfield.

Should the Commission decide to do so, it will have regard to evidence contained in submissions made in response to our initial and draft recommendations consultations.

The Commission's final recommendations for Enfield will now be published on 4 February 2020.

The Commission would like to hear whether people support its proposed changes and the reasons for their views. We therefore encourage those who have a view on these revised proposals to write to us, whether they agree with them or not.

All representations received during the consultation period will be taken into account and the Commission will then consider the evidence received prior to the publication of its final recommendations.
