

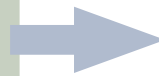

Currently there are:

- 48 councillors
- 16 wards
- 3 councillors per ward



We are proposing:

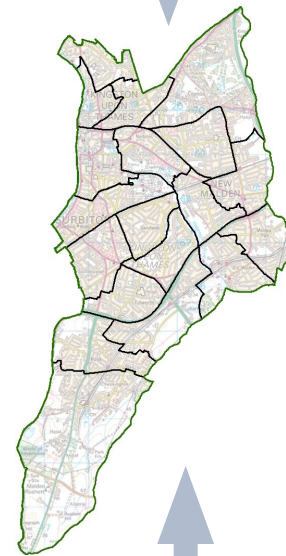
- 48 councillors
- 19 wards
- 2 or 3 councillors per ward



A public consultation is open until
27 July 2020

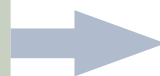


We aim to make sure Kingston
upon Thames councillors represent a
similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- One ward that is more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- No wards that are more than 30% away from the average



Our proposals mean that:

- No wards will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 2,573 electors
