helped shape our recommendations

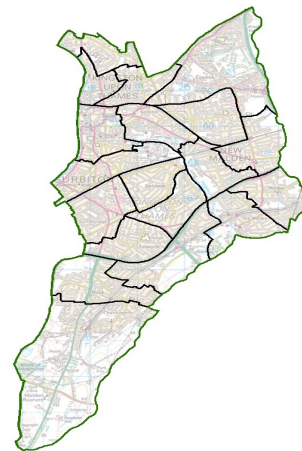


We aim to make sure Kingston upon
Thames councillors represent a
similar number of electors



From the 2022 elections:

- 48 councillors
- 10 three-councillor and 9 two-councillor wards



Currently there are:

- One ward (Canbury 26%) is more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward.
- No wards are more than 30% away from the average

2025 will move towards:

- No wards are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor representing an average of 2,573 electors
