NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

Currently there are:

- 60 councillors
- 20 wards
- Three councillors per ward

We are proposing:

- 60 councillors
- 21 wards
- Two or three councillors per ward

A public consultation is open until
14 September 2020



We aim to make sure Waltham
Forest councillors represent a similar
number of electors



Currently:

- Four wards are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- By 2025 this is projected to increase to nine wards

Our proposals mean that:

- No wards will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 3,218 electors
