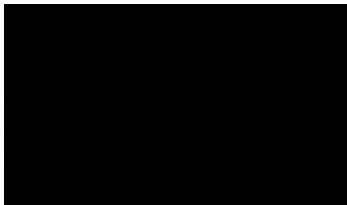

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2018

Made on 29 November 2018

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council ("the Council"), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated September 2018. In reaching these recommendations, and in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, the Council has consulted with the local government electors in the Borough and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 86(3) of the 2007 Act, has sought and received the agreement of the Local Government Boundary Commission to change the electoral arrangements that are protected.

In accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, the Council has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

1. Citation and commencement

(1) This Order may be cited as the Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2018.

(2) This Order comes into force:

(a) for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of councillors, on the day after this Order is made;

(b) for all other purposes, on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2019.

2. Interpretation

In this Order-

"borough" means the borough of Knowsley;

"map" means the map marked "The Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2018" and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act;

"ordinary day of election of councillors" has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983; and

"registration officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

3. Effect of order

- (1) This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.
- (2) Articles 4(2), 4(3) and 4(4) of this Order amend the Schedule to the Knowsley (Electoral Changes) Order 2015.

4. Number of parish councillors

- (1) The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Cronton is the number specified in the second column of Table 1 in the Schedule.
- (2) The number of councillors to be elected for each parish ward in the parish of Knowsley specified in the first column of Table 2 in the Schedule is the number specified in relation to that ward in the second column of Table 2 in the Schedule.
- (3) The number of councillors to be elected for each parish ward in the parish of Prescott specified in the first column of Table 3 in the Schedule is the number specified in relation to that ward in the second column of Table 3 in the Schedule.
- (4) The number of councillors to be elected for each parish ward in the parish of Whiston specified in the first column of Table 4 in the Schedule is the number specified in relation to that ward in the second column of Table 4 in the Schedule.
- (5) The wards and parishes are as shown on the map.


Electoral register

5. The registration officer for the borough shall make such arrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purpose of, and in consequence of, this Order.

Order date

6. 1st April 2019 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

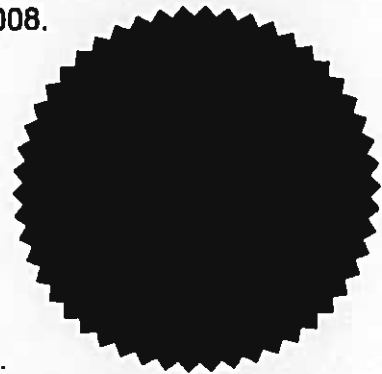

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council for the alteration of the number of councillors to be elected to the parishes of Cronton, Knowsley, Prescott and Whiston within the borough of Knowsley, amending the Knowsley (Electoral Changes) Order 2015 in this respect.

The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2019.

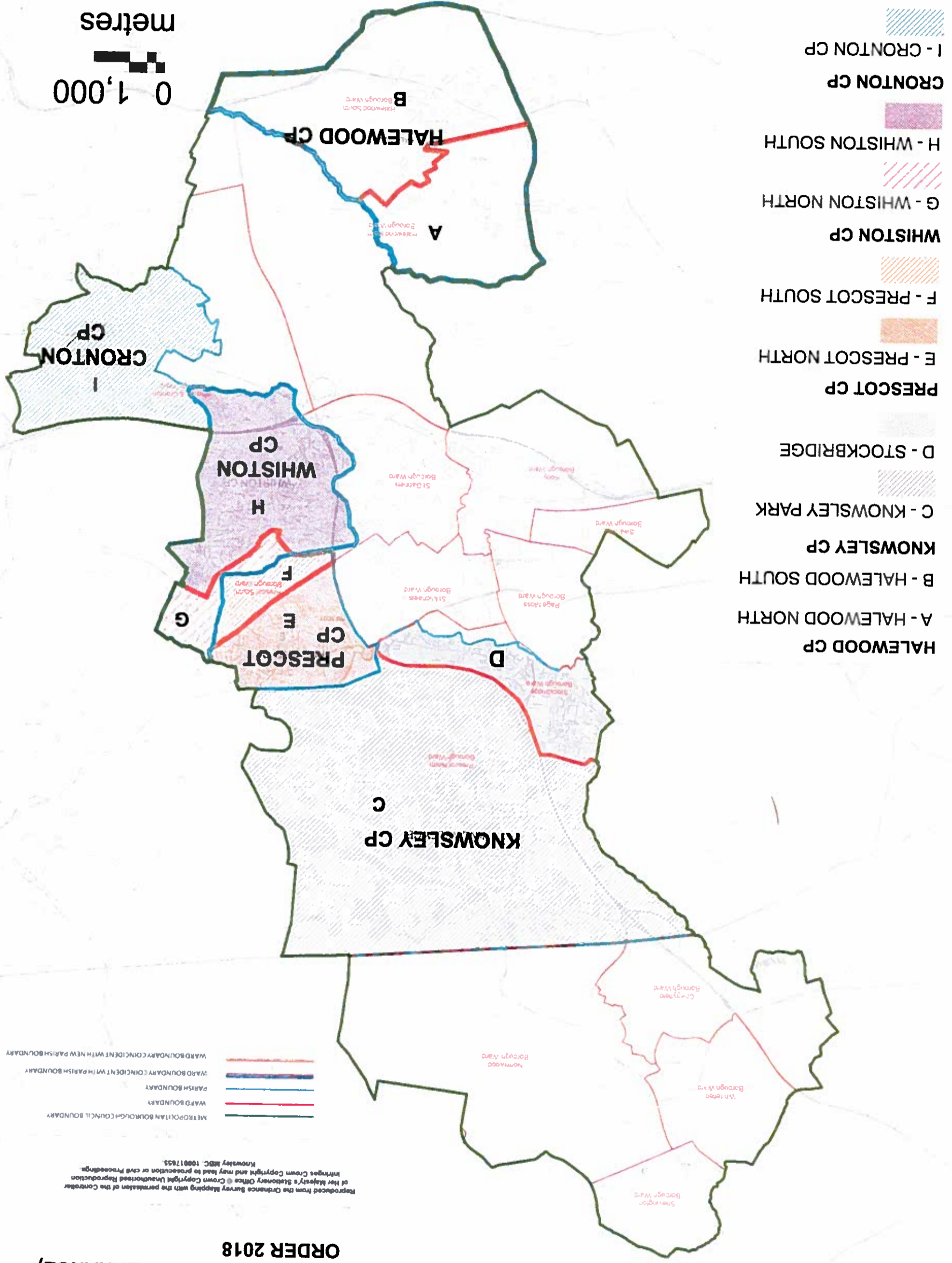
Article 4 specifies the numbers of parish councillors for each of the parishes.
