### Comment text:

Littlemore Parish Council notes the changes proposed in the review of Oxford City Council ward boundaries. If implemented, the new arrangements will mean that Littlemore city councillors will represent the second largest electorate in the city. This is unfair. Every polling district in Littlemore parish falls within the lowest decile on the city deprivation index. This level of disadvantage causes more work, and more important work, for our councillors than in more affluent parts of Oxford. We also believe that the projected growth of Littlemore is likely to increase the size of the electorate to a greater extent than your figures indicate. 426 new residential properties are under proposal to Oxford City Council planning department and outline planning permission has been granted for 410 of these, as well as other individual permissions. Littlemore Parish Council strongly supports the comments of Oxford City Council, that some streets at the northeast corner of Littlemore should be moved into the Cowley polling area.
