Warwick District Council Boundary Review Submission to the Boundary Commission 1. Summary. 1.1.The joint submission from Labour, Lib Dems, Green Party and Whitnash Residents is supported. 1.2. The submission by the Conservatives is rejected and abandonment of the review would be preferred. 2. Reasons. 2.1.The Boundary Commission reviewed Ward boundaries for Warwickshire County Council, introducing the new boundaries in 2017. This was supported and led to boundaries for cohesive communities. A different decision one year later would undermine the previous review. 2.2.The reason given for this review taking place is to enable a merger of the District and County Councils at a future date. The funding reductions have halved our Councils and we only need half the number of Councillors. 2.3.Warwick Town Council boundaries will inevitably have to be reviewed if WDC boundaries change. There is no sensible scheme which can be devised if the Conservative proposals were to be accepted.
