As a local resident, I am broadly supportive of the proposal put forward by the Licensing and Regulatory Committee of Warwick District Council. Of particular note, I wish to note my approval of the recommendation by the Licensing and Regulatory Committee to include Avenue Road and Spencer's Yard in Clarendon Ward - both roads are an important part of the Town Centre. They share an identity and sense of community with the town centre, and it would be deeply damaging to the feel of the town if they were removed from Clarendon Ward. To remove them would undermine the importance of community to council wards. Being part of the County Division of Clarendon, the proposal put forward by the Licensing Committee would use sensible natural boundaries, and appears to allow maximum benefit to be derived from upcoming District Council projects, such as the Creative Quarter initiative. In addition the recommendation to remap Newbold Comyn into Newbold Ward is eminently sensible and corrects the current nonsensical situation.
