Sir/Madam,

On Monday 10th December 2012, at their full Council meeting, Rotherfield Peppard Parish Council agreed that the Boundary Commission Proposal is **not suitable** for Rotherfield Peppard primarily for the following reasons:

- 10 parishes are too many for a single ward (even with 2 members), and
- Woodcote and Rotherfield Peppard are disparate in character.
- Also as

Rotherfield Peppard Parish Council also agreed that the **SODC proposal was preferred** for the following reasons

- It is a single member ward - the Localism Act and Neighbourhood plan are driven at the Parish level, so a single member ward is preferred.
- It contains all the Nettlebed Estate Common Land thin the same ward.
