and this land is the historical centre of Rayleigh  
Rayleigh Mount is the site of a Norman castle - Three Storeys  
and is owned by the National Trust. I have been the Vice-  
Chairman of the local Committee which maintains this site - and  
raises funds to maintain it, as when it was given to  
the National Trust, it was not cultivated.

This land has a windmill - restored in recent years - and  
an ancient Parish house. The great David Owen is  
connected to the land - it is his home which has historical  
connections, I cannot, as Chairman of the Trust, do more  
than recommend the title to be retained.
