### Comment text:

Sir, We are a community of over 1000 residents' 130 acres 700 dwellings in the area west and south west of Ashby Canal and east and north east of Watling St (A5) right next to but outside of Warwickshire. Though we are recorded and recognised by the Borough Council (Hinckley & Bosworth) Leicestershire list our organisation but will not recognise us as a community. At several of our AGMs it has been said because we are linked to Nuneaton we would benefit more by inclusion in Warwickshire since we are not respected by Leicestershire. In 2000 we had only in total 130 homes these being on our main road Coventry Rd (B4666) we then were simply referred to as lower Coventry Rd. Since then almost our entire green space (farm fields) have been built over. Because of easier access to Nuneaton where many of our residents work, shop and socialise rather than Hinckley town, we feel whilst the County Council has no respect for us as a community more inclusion with Leicestershire would be against our interest. We would therefore suggest the county boundary is re-set to be based here on two waterways Harrow brook (tributary of Warwickshire's River Anker) and Ashby Canal at the points where they cross the Watling Street therefore including our community of Saxon Paddock into the County of Warwickshire it being a ward or part of the ward of St. Nicholas, Nuneaton.
