I have been passed your e-mail address from a neighbour in the village (Abbotts Ann), and am having to ask a friend with a computer to send you this response as I do not have a computer myself.

There has been no publicity to my knowledge in this village about the review or the deadline, and I only learned about it by chance. The parish council has not apparently seen fit to alert the public to these changes.

My only comment regarding a boundary change would be to assign all the land of Burghclere Down, i.e. North of the A303, to an appropriate ward of Andover Town, as it is separated physically from the rural parish of Abbotts Ann by this major road, and its character is distinctly different from the village - modern and urban, rather than ancient and traditional.

Perhaps you would please pass these comments on to the relevant quarter.
