The Local Government Boundary Commission

7<sup>th</sup> May 2017

I write this submission on behalf of HOME Residents Association which sits in the heart of current Addiscombe Ward. Our association has existed since 2004. The previous boundary review was in 2002.

The current proposal would split out residents association within two wards , by placing Elgin Road into the Addiscombe West and the rest of our roads into Addiscombe East.

We would appreciate if you would amend the boundary and move it between Elgin and to Clyde Road.

We would also like to see the name of Addiscombe East changed into Addiscombe Village.

“We also aim to ensure that the pattern of wards reflects the interests and identities of local communities as well as promoting effective local government. In order to achieve these aims, we need to re-draw ward boundaries across Croydon.”

The current proposal is forced, creating unnatural wards with communities that do not share same concerns or same environment. As an example – for some reason including the small community in the North part of the Addiscombe East, it is obvious from the map – which has no connection in any way with our locality or community, and not placing it with the Addiscombe West – which is oriented to East Croydon and has specific problems due to its bordering with Croydon Central Development Area.
