Dear Sirs,

My representation is to request that the ward boundary of Grayshott remains as is. The population size is extremely close to the Commission's expected average and the boundary currently drawn conforms to major local natural and man made features, (valleys, heath, roads).

By way of note I would like to record again that there is a strong interest in extending the ward boundary to the A333 in Hindhead for community cohesion reasons but as this would extend the size of the District Council I believe such a consideration is outside the scope. Unfortunately this aspiration seems always to be out of scope of all Boundary Commission reviews; County, Constituency and District and so one is left unclear how this question could be addressed.
