The Milton Keynes (Parishes) (No.2) Order 1986

<u>Made</u>	25th March 1986
<u>Coming into Operation</u>	31st March 1986

Whereas the Milton Keynes Borough Council, acting pursuant to section 48(3) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a), has made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals about parishes in the borough:

And whereas in consequence of those recommendations the Commission has seen fit, pursuant to sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, to make proposals to the Secretary of State:

And whereas more than six weeks has elapsed since those proposals were made:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to the proposals, and has implemented the proposals contained in the Milton Keynes (Parish of Newport Pagnell) Order 1985 (b) and the Milton Keynes (Parishes) Order 1986 (c) :

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Milton Keynes (Parishes) (No.2) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 31st March 1986.

District electoral arrangements

2. The unparished area of the former urban district of Newport Pagnell not transferred by the orders hereinabove recited shall form part of the Linford ward of the borough of Milton Keynes.
