As regards to the review of Rockford District Councils Wards, I have for some years thought it extraordinary that Ashingdon is split into 3 different boundaries.

Most of Ashingdon is lumped together with Canewdon which is fine as that part is very rural. Then another part is included in the Rockford Area. The part I have lived in for the past 52 years is, however, included in North Hawkwell, with which we have little in common. Surely, it would be better for this part, which is much more residential, to be included in Rockford. In fact, ludicrously, Ashingdon Road, is half in one Ward and half in another!

Furthermore, Ashingdon is not even part of our address any more, only Rockford. Also, whilst St. Andrew's Church Ashingdon is our nearest Church, our Parish Church is St. Andrew's Rockford, which is now closed! None of this makes sense.

It seems to me it would be far simpler to include all Roads East of Rectory Avenue, into Rockford.
