The Blaby District Council (Reorganisation of Community  
Governance) Order 2016

Made *22nd September* 2016

Coming into force in accordance with article 1 (2)

Blaby District Council ("the council"), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations.

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3), and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

**Citation and Commencement**

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Blaby District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2016.  
(2) Subject to paragraph (3) and (4) below, this Order comes into force on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019.  
(3) Article 5 shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2019.  
(4) For the purposes of proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of parish councillors for the parish of Leicester Forest East, to be held on the
